CONTINUING EDUCATION

This comprehensive program will cover liability for and prevention of elder abuse and is designed for CPAs, attorneys and other professionals and fiduciaries who would like to gain an understanding of the area of law so as to prevent and mitigate abuse on behalf of their clients, and to avoid exposure to liability arising from alleged abuse.

While the program will focus on financial and fiduciary abuse, it will also address physical abuse and neglect and the interrelationship between the two types of abuse.
